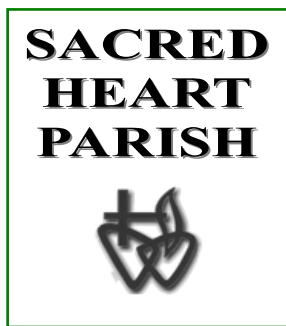

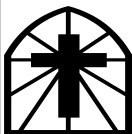

Please spread the word in your community and come along yourself. It is always an enjoyable festival rich in music, costume and ritual.

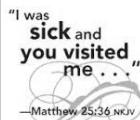
A retreat for those who received the sacrament of Confirmation takes place in the parish Centre this Friday 6th June.
